

Ashini property, Uranium

Ressources Appalaches (APP-TSXV) is a Canadian company pursuing mineral exploration for base metals, gold and uranium. The company holds a substantial land position with a combined 136 km² in 11 uranium properties in Quebec, Canada and is seeking partnership for the those properties.

Work performed

Stripping operations at the Ashini property have so far identified four zones of uranium mineralization over a north-south distance of 4.7 kilometers. These zones consist of a number of veins of uranium-bearing pegmatite. The grades of selected grab samples range from 0.02% to 0.22% U.

22 short holes have been drilled in 2008 over an area of 300 m by 500 m (zone #3). Half of those holes hit pegmatite with more than 0,01 % U.
